

Healing Scriptures (continued)

As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" When he saw them, he said, **"Go, show yourselves to the priests."** And as they went, they were cleansed. (Lk 17:12-14)

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him. (Acts 10:38)

Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well. (3 Jn 2)

Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed the Christ there. When the crowds heard Philip and saw the miraculous signs he did, they all paid close attention to what he said. With shrieks, evil spirits came out of many, and many paralytics and cripples were healed. So there was great joy in that city. (Acts 8:5-8)

Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off — for all whom the Lord our God will call." (Acts 2:38-39)

The assurance we have in approaching God: if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us- whatever we ask- we know that we have what we asked for. (1Jn 5:14)

PRAYER: "Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. Stretch out your hand to heal and perform miraculous signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus (Who lives in me).

After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly" (Acts 4:29-31)

ANSWER: So Paul and Barnabas spent considerable time there, speaking boldly for the Lord, who confirmed the message of his grace by enabling them to do miraculous signs and wonders. (Acts 14:3)

Sin & Sickness Connection

This is not to say that ALL health issues are a result of sin, but often, there is a connection

"See, you are well again. Stop sinning or something worse may happen to you." (Jn 5:14)

"Which is easier: to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'? But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins. . . ." Then he said to the paralytic, "Get up, take your mat and go home." (Mt 9:4-7)

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 Jn 1:9)

Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment on himself. That is why many among you are weak and sick, and a number of you have fallen asleep. (1 Cor 11:27-30)

Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven. Therefore confess your sins to each other so that you may be healed. (James 5:14-16)

"No one can enter a strong man's house and carry off his possessions unless he first ties up the strong man. Then he can rob his house." (Mk 3:27)

"The evil deeds of a wicked man ensnare him; the cords of his sin hold him fast.

He will die for lack of discipline, led astray by his own great folly." (Prov 5:22-23)

"If men are bound in chains, held fast by cords of affliction, he tells them what they have done- that they have sinned arrogantly.

He makes them listen to correction and commands them to repent of their evil.

If they obey and serve him, they will spend the rest of their days in prosperity and their years in contentment.

But if they do not listen, they will perish by the sword and die without knowledge." (Job 36:8-12)

"Throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles." (Heb. 12:1)

"I cried out to him with my mouth; his praise was on my tongue. If I had cherished sin in my heart, YAHWEY would not have listened; but God has surely listened and heard my voice in prayer." (Ps 66:17-19)

"But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear. (Isa 59:2)

"He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them finds mercy." (Prov 28:13)

"Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him; for God's temple is sacred, and you are that temple." (1 Cor 3:16-17)

Exhortation to Heal

...but you do not take care of the flock. You have not strengthened the weak or healed the sick or bound up the injured. (Ez 34:3)

Therefore, strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees. Make level paths for your feet, so that the lame may not be disabled, but rather healed. (Heb 12:12-13)

...Asa was afflicted with a disease in his feet. Though his disease was severe, even in his illness he did not seek help from the LORD, but only from the physicians. (2Ch 16:12)

Kingdom Faith

Christ’s Commission & Authority To Heal

“**The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach the good news to the poor.**

He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor.” (Lk 4:18-19)

“But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.” (Mt 12:28)

[Jesus] said to them, **“Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will accompany those who believe. In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.”**

After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God. Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, **and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.** (Mk 16:15-20)

Jesus said, **“All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded**

you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” (Mt 28:18-20)

He called his [12] disciples to him and gave them authority to drive out evil spirits and to heal every disease and sickness... **Go rather to the lost sheep of Israel. As you go, preach this message: ‘The kingdom of heaven is near.’ Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.”** (Mt 10:1, 6-8)

“Go! I am sending you [72] out like lambs among wolves...Heal the sick who are there and tell them, ‘The kingdom of God is near you.’ ...He who listens to you listens to me; he who rejects you rejects me; but he who rejects me rejects him who sent me.”

...The seventy-two returned with joy and said, **“Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name.”** He replied, **“I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. However do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”** (Lk 10:3-20)

“I tell you the truth, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

“Again, I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them.” (Mt 18:18-20)

“The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work. Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe in the evidence of the miracles themselves. I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.

You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.” (Jn 14:10-14)

“Have faith in God.” Jesus answered. **“I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, ‘Go, throw yourself into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. Therefore, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.”** (Mk 11:22-24)

Healing Scriptures

“Praise YAHWEY, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. Praise YAHWEY, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits — who forgives all [my] sins and heals all [my] diseases, who redeems [my] life from the pit and crowns [me] with love and compassion, who satisfies [my] desires with good things so that [my] youth is renewed like the eagle’s.” (Ps 103:1-5)

I am YAHWEY [RAPHA who heals you. (Ex 15:26)

He sent his word and healed them. (Ps 107:20)

“Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.” (Isa 53: 4-5)

“He himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, that we might die to sin, and live unto righteousness; for by His stripes you were healed.” (1 Pt 2:24)

The reason the Son of Man appeared was to destroy the devil’s work. (1 Jn 3:8)

“When evening came, many who were demon possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: ‘He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases.’” (Mt 8:16-17)

“Go back and report to John what you have seen and heard: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor...” (Lk 7:22-23)

Jesus went through Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people. (Mt 4:23)

People brought all their sick to him and begged him to let the sick just touch the edge of his cloak, and all who touched him were healed. (Mt 14: 35-36)
